

Toxic Substances Control Act Declaration

Regulation of Persistent Bioaccumulative and Toxic Chemicals

Issued on 20 May 2026

The United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) has issued a rule, under Section 6(h) of the Toxic Substances Control Act (TSCA), which will phase out the use of 5 Persistent Bioaccumulative and Toxic (PBT) substances:

Decabromodiphenyl ether	(DecaBDE)	CAS No. 1163-19-5
Phenol, Isopropylated Phosphate	(PIP (3:1))	CAS No. 68937-41-7
2,4,6-Tri-tert-butylphenol	(2,4,6 TTBP)	CAS No. 732-26-3
Hexachlorobutadiene	(HCBd)	CAS No. 87-68-3
Pentachlorothiophenol	(PCTP)	CAS No. 133-49-3
